What do you do and where?

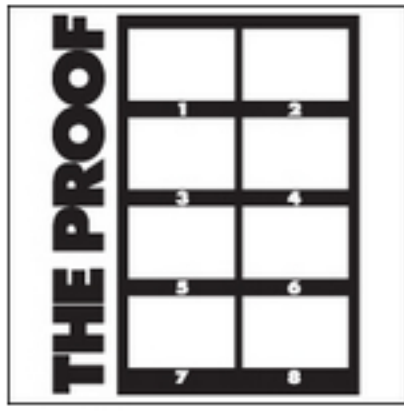
I'm a full time visual artist working from my cozy little studio in my home.

What are you working on?

I'm currently working on a new 16 piece series entitled "True Beauty: An Untouched Project".
