Before the shoot we discussed the type and style of image to be used and I think that this is perhaps the best. A very desolate landscape, ruins, smoke. It works well, this is just one version, I messed about with the white balance on a number of the shots and they produced crazy colours, very deep purples, deep blues, vivid reds, they were amazing. We are now collaborating on a promo video which will hopefully be released next week.
