Patrick Connors - Toronto: Malinda Prud'homme is in her second year as a professional artist. "The first year was a struggle financially", she admitted. "Luckily, (her fiancee) Darren is very supportive of me pursuing art full time. Now, work is coming in more steadily, partly through Facebook, Twitter, and free ads.

"I have also done a varied body of work, from a commissioned piece appearing in the lobby of the office where I used to work, to a book cover. However, portraiture is my passion.

"I like to focus a lot on faces, to celebrate each woman's uniqueness. To stop with all the cover up of natural beauty."

Prud'homme comes across as someone who believes very strongly in her vision and her talent, while also seeking to bring people into a dialogue which will be mutually beneficial.

This weekend, she takes part in the inaugural "Art Walk North", presented by the Artists Network, at Mel Lastman Square. She will be in Booth 42 on Friday, August 16th, from 11:00 AM-8:00 PM, and on Saturday, August 17th, from 11:00 AM-6:00 PM.
